## Odom says Martin Dies on the mend

Park manager Dan Odom presented an update on repair projects and refilling Steinhagen Lake to the volunteer group Friends of Martin Dies, Jr. State Park at their monthly meeting Oct. 12.

The park, severely damaged by Hurricane Rita, has not been completely restored due to a long wait for clean up and reconstruction funds.

Only the Henhouse Ridge unit, containing 90 of the 227 campsites, is open.

The lake, drawn down to rid it of excessive vegetation, will be refilled as soon as repairs are completed on the bridge across U.S. Highway 190 and the dam.

The bridge work should be completed in three weeks and dam repairs by the end of November, Odom said.

That would mean that water could be released at that time.

"Because Rayburn is so

low, that doesn't necessarily mean that water will be released immediately," Odom said. "There are also sloughs to the north of the park that refill first."

Even without the lake, the park is seeing an increase in visitors.

"Henhouse Ridge is open and we are full next weekend," Odom said. "People are slowly starting to come back and we get a lot of calls."

Some of those calls are to check on activities that are scheduled every year.

Odom said that families have been calling about the annual Haunted Halloween Hike, for example.

"That's an activity that families are used to coming to and we will have it," he said. "We had to move it to the Henhouse Ridge unit so it won't be the same place, but it is scheduled for Saturday, Oct. 28."

Structural repairs and additional cleanup will soon begin in the Walnut Ridge unit. Fifteen shelters and the nature center were

damaged by storm and are still awaiting repair.

"Structural repairs were delayed because of insurance issues," Odom said. "That has been worked out. The money is now in place and will be released soon. We have a small crew from Texas Parks and Wildlife coming. They estimate nine months of work; however, by using some of our staff and volunteers, we could get the work done in less time."

The park also has a contract with the Texas Department of Corrections so there are some funds available for a crew from TDC to begin work.

Volunteer help was restricted after the storm because of the danger of downed and leaning timber.

Sufficient clearing of debris has now made it possible to accept help from groups and/or individuals. "We won't turn down

volunteers," Odom said. "We have already had groups work on trails twice. We also had a family camped here who helped. Volunteers could help us a lot. Anyone wanting to help should call the office first, however, so we have a specific job lined up."

Members of the Friends group asked questions about the economic impact to the Jasper area.

Odom said that the park ordinarily generated \$350,000 per year and that has been down to a trickle since the storm and the draining of the lake.

"We had already done \$20,000 in business last September before the storm hit," he said. "That year, in April alone, we took in \$64,000; so I would say that the park has a big impact on the Jasper area. We usually get 250,000 to 300,000 visitors a year. It used to be that out of town visitors came

from the Beaumont-Port Arthur area, but in the past several years, 60 percent are from the Houston area and they don't mind spending money."

Odom and his staff are adamant that weekend activities continue because so many of their visitors come here to participate in special events.

In addition to the Haunted Halloween Hike which begins at 6pm

Saturday, Oct. 28, the annual Cowboy Campfire is scheduled for Nov. 25. and the Holiday Celebration, featuring the Gingerbread design and construction marathon is set for Dec. 9.

The staff also continues the weekend Walk on the Wild Side interpretive hikes every month, and they remain optimistic about getting back to normal.

"We'll be back," Odom said. "We will be back."
