## Check, service fire safety equipment

Jasper Fire Marshal Stephen Williamson reported that fire extinguishers seem to be a common problem as he continues business inspections throughout the city.

"Fire extinguishers are the first defense in fighting a fire and must be maintained properly," Williamson said. "Taking time to check your extinguisher is important to making sure you are prepared should a situation arise."

Fire extinguishers should be mounted at least 12" off the floor and no higher than five feet above the floor where they are easily accessible. A fire extinguisher should never be blocked or hidden, according to Williamson. Fire extinguishers in businesses should be serviced by a fire extinguisher company annually. The gauge on fire extinguishers should be checked monthly at the same time smoke detectors are tested.
