Please call Gulf South immediately if you notice any of the following signs along its rights-of-way:

- Construction or digging
- Hissing or roaring that may be caused by escaping gas
- Unusual blowing of dust, dirt, grass or leaves near a pipeline
- Dead plants or vegetation amid healthy ones
- Flames coming from the ground or from valves along a pipeline route
- Steady bubbling in streams, ponds or wet areas
- Suspicious-looking activity
