PUBLIC NOTICE BURKEVILLE SCHOOL 2007 TRUSTEE ELECTION CANCELLED Burkeville ISD previously announced a school board election for positions 6 and 7 sched-

uled for November of 2007. That announcement was inadvertently released in error and has been cancelled effective immediately. The 80th Texas Legislature enacted TEC 11.0581 of the Texas Education Code with requires a school district to hold trustee elections jointly with state and county officers if there is no incorporated municipality within bounds of the school district as with Burkeville. The Attorney General ruled on April 04, 2007, opinion GA-0535 that districts without municipalities within their bounds must reschedule 2007 school board elections (including but not limited to those postponed from May 2007) to November 2007 to continue school trustee elections on the uniform November election date only in even-numbered years, thereafter. The mandated information was neither well communicated to relevant school districts nor at general election workshops subsequent to those actions.

SB 670, also enacted by the 80th Legislature, amends TEC Code that a resolution must be passed by school boards without municipalities changing the length of school trustee terms for four years from three year terms prior to December 31, 2007. In pursuit of that resolution, Burkeville ISD learned only later that we could not legally host an election in November of 2007. The office of the Secretary of State directed the District on 09/19/07 to postpone the November 2007 election to November 11, 2008. Positions up for election in 2008 will be not only 6 and 7 but also 1 and 2 so four positions will expire. The other three positions (3-5) will be in November of 2010. Anyone requesting early election ballots will be getting letters instead expressing regret at the inconvenience of such a late postponement of the election. The apology is also extended to the civic minded candidates who filed for positions at this time in vain.
